**President Report:**

Fundraisers were discussed. We will be doing the pizza kits once again. Also brought up was possibly holding a Bass Tournament. The Golf Tournament was also discussed.

**Chairperson positions still open:**

**Chaperone:** all that is required to do is call or email parents to chaperon, you do not need to go on every trip as a chaperon chair, just find parents to go.

**Tom Pickard:** The trailer is nonfunctional at this time. We are still in need of tie downs; this will help hold the equipment in place. The preliminary design is finished for downstairs. (This is taped off in the band hall for all to see) There is a list of wood that is needed for this phase of the project which is estimated at \$700. This is not including electrical. It was brought up that Willshire might donate lumber if we get a donation letter to him on VR Band letterhead. Covey Roofing did volunteer to help outfit the trailer for advertising space. The trailer will need to be sandblasted outside and repainted. Ramps and graphics still need to be worked out. There is need for new wheels to be put on the speaker cabinets. The old wheels were not adequate enough to roll the speakers out onto the field; \$150 is needed for that.

**Jeff Garcia** was in charge of the chaperons at last Friday's game. All went well.

**Band Director Report:** Kids doing great and are working hard. They had a great performance Friday. Trip payment schedule will be put out shortly.
