

## **Band Booster Minutes August 16, 2007**

Kim Black, President, called the meeting to order. It was announced that Karen Moore has replaced Cheryl Jacoby as VRBB Treasurer and Sharon Powell has replaced Lori Roeckers as Parliamentarian. Recognition was given to both Cheryl and Lori for their tremendous help and assistance.

Donna Powell, Secretary, went over the minutes from the May 2007, Band Booster Meeting. The minutes were approved.

Karen Moore, Treasurer, gave a status report that she was in the process of going over the books/accounts and was aiming to mail out a statement soon regarding the individual accounts.

Gracie Weatherly, Hospitality Chair, gave a report and gratitude for those that had helped in providing food for the kids so far during summer band.

There is a swim party for the band members from 4:30 to 7:30 on Friday, August 17<sup>th</sup> providing the HOA will allow them to come over an hour earlier.

The Band Exhibition/Social was discussed and is scheduled for Friday, August 24, starting at 7:30 p.m. at the VRHS Stadium. The Journey will be providing food, beverages & entertainment.

Result from the Pet Clinic on Monday, August 13<sup>th</sup> was discussed and we netted a little over \$1,000. It was announced we would host another Pet Clinic on January 17<sup>th</sup>.

Next Fundraiser will be the Passbooks and will begin on Thursday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Each student will be given 2 Passbooks to sell – up to 5 if they request them. The cost of each is \$20. The total profit is 50% (\$10) – the student account gets \$8 and the Band gets \$2. We will need volunteers to help before and after school to hand out books and collect the money.

Another fundraising opportunity is the Hill Country News (the local community newspaper). They have started their annual promotion of *The Weekender* – the Friday edition of the news that brings you the honor roll, previews of school plays, complete coverage of Vista Ridge extracurricular activities and much, much more! For every subscription to *The Weekender* received with “VR Band Boosters” noted as the school organization, VRBB will receive \$10. There are currently order forms from the newspaper that you can cut out and mail in – but you would need to make sure and put “VR Band Boosters” as the benefiting organization.

Janelle Brick discussed the Vista Ridge Band March-A-Thon will be on Saturday, September 22, in the Forest Oaks Subdivision. They are still trying to secure permits and make the arrangements.

The next meeting of the General Assembly of the VRBB is Tuesday September 11, 2007, at 7 pm.
