

General Meeting Minutes

October 9, 2007

Meeting was called to order by President Kim Black at 7:04 pm.

Minutes were reviewed and a date correction was made on September Minutes. Date should have read September 11, not October 9th. Motion for approval of August minutes was made by Mary Ellen Sellars and seconded by Amy Bissonette. Motion for approval of September minutes with date change was made by Rex Bissonette and seconded by Amy Bissonette.

Treasurer Report given by Karen Moore: We have a balance of \$57370.12 in the General Fund. Balance of SCRIP account is \$3410.86. We have paid \$30532.54 in Expenses and have received \$15706.84 in Deposits. We have \$12K reserve, over \$6K for Percussion BOA trip. The trailer has been turned over to the District. Their insurance is covering the trailer. They have applied for the tags.

Historian Report given by Karen Blandford: She has been getting pictures of the various events. Pictures can be sent to her or emailed to Jerry Cooper to be posted on the VRBB website.

Chaperone Report given by Oscar and Carmen Garza: Kathleen will be in charge of upcoming events for Friday and Saturday. Also discussed was that the chaperone's names will be added to the roll call list for each bus.

Colorguard Report: Flags are done..YEAH!!

Concession Report given by Sherry Douglas: We have been asked to run concession stand at Wylie on Sat Nov 3rd. She will get info out as we get closer to actual date.

Fundraising Report given by Rex Bissonette: Thanks to Kathleen for her help with fundraising events. Possible upcoming events: Spaghetti Dinner and Firehouse Subs.

Kim reported that we received \$250.96 from Festival of Bands.

SCRIP report given by Kathleen Morino: Michaels is now participating in SCRIP.

Holiday Bazaar report given by Sharon Powell: Cedar Park Signs changed the date on the signs for free. We still need to get permits. We need someone to help with signs, concessions and silent auction & donations. Bazaar will be Sat, Nov 17th, from 10-4. There will be a flier going out next week to Elementary schools and it will be posted on the Booster website.

Drumline needs a \$600 sponsor for BOA.

There will be another Pet Clinic in January. We need to add to the calendar.

Hospitality Report given by Gracie Weatherly: She is open to any input and suggestions. Things running smoothly.

Pit Crew Report given by Charles Davis: There are 18 people that have been cleared to help. Twenty-five had signed up. He will be calling everyone. We need at least 6-8 each event.

Scholarship Report given by Mary Ellen Sellars: We received documents from Cedar Park HS as well as Stony Point in Round Rock. She needs to combine, tweak, etc. Currently, 10% of proceeds go to scholarship.

Uniform Report given by Lois Wagoner: Uniforms were cleaned last week and are doing well. We are spending \$1170.53 to clean using Image Cleaners. Mr. Christian also mentioned the hem length. Regulation is that bottom of hem be at the top of the shoes.

Website was mentioned, but Jerry Cooper wasn't present to discuss. Kim mentioned that we need someone to train and be ready to take over for next year.

Volunteer activity was mentioned, but Michelle Meharg was not present. Currently, there is a two day turnaround in getting applications processed to volunteer.

Report given by Mr. Christian: The kids are doing well. At Capital City, we received 5th in division. Grouping was determined by number of wind instruments in horn line. Drumline was 25% of score; Guard was 15% of score. For Visual we ranked 4th and 3rd for Musical. He also discussed how scoring will be done at Westlake Marching Festival.

Kim mentioned t-shirts that have been ordered for parents to purchase.
