Minutes from General Meeting  
January 8, 2008

President Kim Black called the meeting to order at 7:01 pm.

There was a brief meeting in December corresponding with the Holiday concert. No minutes were taken as the meeting consisted of announcements of upcoming events. Treasurer Karen Moore gave an update on funds. We had expenses of \$12859.84 and Deposits of \$15655.98. We have \$36790.63 in available funds not including BOA funds. We made \$4355 from the Holiday Bazaar.

Committee Chair Reports:

Color Guard: Anne Coburn – There needs to be a parent meeting ASAP to discuss schedule, fees, uniforms, etc. They are trying to get it set up. AnnaLisa popped in and gave dates for competitions: 1/26, 3/1, 3/22, 4/5 with possibly an additional competition in March.

Concessions: Sherry Douglas – Thanked everyone that had helped with All Region Concessions.

Fundraising: Rex & Amy Bissonnette – We made \$174.92 from Firehouse Subs fundraiser. There is a Pet Clinic coming up on 1/16/07 from 5-7. Kim Black is overseeing merchandise being sold at the school store. Kathleen Marino gave an update on SCRIP. There are new order forms. JCPenney is offering a gift certificate in the amount of \$500 and \$750 and \$1K in February to schools with highest SCRIP sales. Holiday Bazaar – Sharon said we will likely pick a date here soon for next Bazaar.

Scholarship: Mary Ellen Sellars – The scholarship fund is set up. Info will come out in April on it. 10% of fundraisers goes in to the account.

Website: Jerry Cooper – It was recognized by Kim that Mr. Villareal will be assisting Jerry and taking over at end of year.

Volunteer: Michelle Meharg – we need to send in volunteer hours to Michelle

New Business:
