Dear Band Parent,

The band staff is very excited about the number of students that have elected to participate in the band programs at Leander I.S.D. As we grow in numbers, we also hope to grow in quality. We are constantly striving to improve the band program, ourselves as professionals, as well as our student's musical abilities. As the school year begins, we hope you share in this excitement with us.

Band teaches so much more than "just playing music." Band teaches diligence through preparation, practice and repetition of musical skills such as rhythms, melody and harmony. Band teaches responsibility through individual work effort, instrument care, and scheduled maintenance. Band teaches group work ethics through ensemble performances, group practice, and group assessment. Over the years of participation in band, students will develop both critical thinking and listening skills as they prepare and perform music. These skills are brought out through performance judgments as they pertain to music. While working in the music ensemble setting, students will develop powers of concentration, the ability to memorize music and parts and the ability to work with others in a group setting. The band student will develop certain physical skills such as stamina, endurance and coordination.
