

Dr. Mark Waymire is in his thirty-sixth year as a music educator. Though now working fulltime as a consultant, lecturer, adjudicator, and designer, he was most recently a Music Education professor at The University of Southern Mississippi. Prior to completing his PhD at The University of Mississippi, Dr. Waymire was Associate Director of Bands at Eastern Michigan University. His public-school experience includes work in Louisiana and Texas, including ten years as Director of Bands, Seguin High School, Seguin, Texas. Personal honors include six H.E.R.O. teaching awards, nine appointments to WHO's WHO in American Education, and two presentations of the National President's Award for Education Excellence. National and International lectures based on Dr. Waymire's research on teaching expertise have been given in California, Mississippi, Georgia, Arkansas, Louisiana, Michigan, Missouri, Tennessee, Texas, Canada, and Scotland. In addition to his high school and collegiate-level designs and directorships, Mark Waymire been a part of the staffs of the following drum corps: Phantom Regiment, Madison Scouts, Spirit of Atlanta, and Glassmen, taking on various roles including both brass and visual caption head positions, as well as designer and program coordinator. Dr. Waymire is an active band clinician and adjudicator which includes associations with BOA, WGI, UIL, and DCI.

Jarrod Huntley- Bluecoats



Founder of Marching Network, Jarrod Huntley is backed by over 25 plus years performing, judging, teaching, and designing in the marching band, winterguard and winter drums activity. 20 of Jarrods 25 plus year career has been spent working with the most premier groups in our activity: The Cadets, The Blue Devils, and Bluecoats drum corps. Jarrod served on the visual staff for the 19-time DCI champion Blue Devils from (2004-2010) and served as Visual Caption Head for the 10-time champion The Cadets from 2011 to 2013. "I'm proud to have helped lead the cadets to a visual title in 2011 and the corps 10th DCI victory; the first victory in over 5 years." In 2014 Jarrod moved back to the visual staff of the Blue Devils where he worked continuously through the 2018 season. In 2019 Jarrod took a new role as Visual Co Caption head for the Bluecoats Drum Corps. Jarrod now service as full time Visual caption head of the Bluecoats Drum Corps. Jarrod is a regular adjudicator for both fall and winter seasons having judged competitions around the world.

As drill designer, Jarrod has a UIL state championship with the Marcus HS band, and a 3rd place BOA nationals medal as drill writer for Hebron HS. Along with his teaching and judging accolades, Jarrod's drill writing has made it possible to work across the world and the country in places including: Europe, Japan, Indonesia, UK, Texas, Florida, California, Virginia, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Missouri, Illinois, Arizona, Colorado, and Nevada. Jarrod has worked with many nationally known groups including: The Company Drum Corps (UK), Hebron HS (Texas), Marcus HS (Texas), Union HS (Oklahoma), Flower Mound HS (Texas), Argyle HS (Texas) Etiwanda H.S. (California), Vista Murrieta HS (California), Marching Band Bontang PKT (Indonesia), The Cadets, The Concord Blue Devils, Bluecoats, The Crossmen, Momentum Winter Drumline, and more. Jarrod now resides in Newport Or. where he lives with his amazing wife and the coolest daughter ever.

Reid Atkinson



Reid Atkinson is an arranger and program coordinator for award winning marching programs across the country. In conjunction with his design work, Reid serves as the Director of Education for Ultimate Drill Book in which he oversees education initiatives for student and directors across UDB's global reach.

Before transitioning to pageantry design, Reid served as a band director for 14 years, most recently as the Marching Director at Vista Ridge High School in Cedar Park, TX. As the marching director, Vista Ridge was recognized with several high honors including a UIL Texas 6A Championship, BOA Grand National finalist, BOA Super Regional medalist, and BOA Regional Champion. Prior to his appointment at Vista Ridge, Mr. Atkinson served as the Director of Bands at Grain Valley High School in Missouri for ten years where the marching band earned multiple AA BOA Division Championships, BOA Super Regional Finals performances, and a performance at the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade.

Mr. Atkinson resides in Leander, Texas with his wife Alison, daughter Ainsley and son Paxton.

Bob Chreste

Bob Chreste currently works as an educational consultant for the music education software, MuseClass. He is also an active arranger, consultant, and adjudicator residing in Texas. Bob spent 16 years as a high school band director at several prominent programs in Texas. During his career, his bands have won the UIL Texas state championship, multiple Bands of America class championships, and several other local marching contests across Texas. Bob is currently the Assistant Brass Caption Head for the Bluecoats Drum & Bugle Corps and has previously worked with Carolina Crown, Santa Clara Vanguard, and The Cadets. He is one of only a few instructors in DCI that have been a brass caption head and a visual caption head at a DCI finalist corps. Bob has been a clinician at the Midwest Clinic, Music for All Summer Symposium, Texas Bandmasters Association, and many other conferences. Mr. Chreste also adjudicates for Bands of America, Winter Guard International, Texas Music Adjudicators Association, and several other local, regional, and state level circuits. His educational background includes receiving his Bachelor of Music Education degree from the University of Houston and his Master of Music in Conducting degree from Sam Houston State University.

Ryan Kilgore



Dr. Matthew "Ryan" Kilgore is a percussionist, arranger, clinician, and adjudicator. With a diverse percussive background, he specializes in keyboard percussion, chamber music, steel band, and the marching arts.

Ryan marched with Kiwanis Kavaliers in 1998 and Bluecoats Drum and Bugle Corps in 1999. He began as an instructor at Bluecoats and Rhythm X in 2008. At Bluecoats, he served on percussion staff from 2008 to 2013 and has been the music ensemble coordinator since 2014. He is also in his 12th year with Rhythm X Indoor Percussion Ensemble and has been part of 3 gold medal seasons. Currently, Ryan is the Director of the Scot Marching Band and Instructor of Percussion at the College of Wooster.

Ryan has his Bachelor of Music in Percussion Performance from Rutgers University, his Master of Music in Percussion Performance and Pedagogy from Northwestern University, and his DMA from the University of North Texas.
